**Loan size:** €5 million

**Borrower:** MI-BOSPO Microcredit

**Aim:** To support micro-enterprises and private households by financing productive investments, working capital and home improvement.

**Aim:** To support job creation and preservation through the partial financing of productive investments in MSMEs as well as the modernisation of public infrastructure.
