1 Czech Republic

Loan: €200 million

Borrower: Komerční banka

Aim: To finance the revitalisation and modernisation of municipal and regional infrastructure, focusing on small municipalities and Just Transition regions.

2 Estonia

Loan: €100 million

Borrower: City of Tallinn

Aim: To co-finance priority investments in education, social care, social housing and urban regeneration to improve quality of life and social inclusion.

3 Germany

Loan: €100 million

Borrower: Leipziger Wohnungs- und Baugesellschaft mbH

Aim: To support the construction and refurbishment of social and affordable rental housing, including refugee accommodation, for vulnerable households in Leipzig.

4 Spain

Loan: €10 million

Borrower: Fundación Secretariado Gitano

Aim: To provide bridge financing for ESF+ co-funded programmes promoting Roma access to employment, education and social inclusion.

5 Spain

Loan: €40 million

Borrower: Ayuntamiento de Rivas-Vaciamadrid

Aim: To support affordable housing, neighbourhood public facilities and urban regeneration, including the reconnection of the city through a comprehensive sustainable mobility project.
