JOINT STATEMENT
between
the Ministry for Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine
and
the Council of Europe Development Bank
on
cooperation for the implementation of
Project “Housing assistance for internally displaced people
from temporarily occupied territory”

The Ministry for Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine (hereinafter – Ministry for Development) and the Council of Europe Development Bank (hereinafter – CEB) (together referred as the “Parties”) affirm their strong partnership in supporting Ukraine’s recovery efforts, particularly in addressing the consequences of forced displacement due to the loss of access to housing in the temporarily occupied territory.

In the context of the successful implementation of the projects “HOME: Compensation for Destroyed Housing” and “Housing for Internally Displaced Persons”, under which more than 6 000 households received new housing, the Ministry for Development and the CEB reaffirm their shared intention to expand and further develop new housing initiatives, in particular by attracting financial resources and support on the implementation of:

The Project “Housing assistance for internally displaced people from temporarily occupied territory” in the amount of €80 000 000 which was approved by the CEB’s Administrative Council on 18 June 2026.

To this end, the Parties are actively working on the preparation and implementation of this new initiative, aimed at expanding housing support for internally displaced persons whose homes remained in the temporarily occupied territory.

The CEB, as the social bank of Europe, remains dedicated to providing financial resources, technical assistance and innovative solutions to support the priorities set by the Ministry for Development. In line with its Strategic Framework 2023-2027 the CEB has already approved loan financing of over €810 million addressing targeted and urgent needs of Ukraine.

The Parties will continue working jointly in the coming weeks to operationalize approved additional international financing to the state established structure, to ensure that such support reaches those eligible and priority groups, in a transparent, timely, and effective manner.
