Vice-Governor for Social Development Strategy

Rosa María Sánchez-Yebra Alonso was appointed Vice-Governor for Social Development Strategy in June 2016 and began her five-year mandate on 19 December 2016.

Before joining the CEB, she was Secretary General of the Treasury and Financial Policy in Spain's Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness. In that capacity, she represented the Ministry in numerous European and international financial fora, such as the European Investment Bank (EIB), the European Stability Mechanism (ESM), the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the G-20, and served as Deputy Minister at the Eurogroup and the Economic and Financial Affairs Council (ECOFIN). She also served as Member of the Board of the Bank of Spain, Member of the Board of the Spanish Securities Supervisor (CNMV), Vice-President of the National Banking Resolution Authority (FROB), and Vice-President of the National Guarantee Deposits Scheme (FGD).

Ms Sánchez-Yebra Alonso has previously held other senior posts in the Spanish administration, including Chief of Staff to Spain's Minister of Economy and Competitiveness and Senior Advisor to the Minister of Finance on the Ministerial Commission of Economic Affairs. She has also worked as Head of the Economic and Commercial Office at the Spanish Embassy in Romania and as Associate Professor at IE Business School.

She has sat, among others, on the Board of Spain's National Promotional Bank (ICO), the Spanish State Agency for Trade Promotion (ICEX), the Spanish State Agency for Export Credit Financing (CESCE), and the State Holding of Corporations (SEPI).

Ms Sánchez-Yebra Alonso is a Member of the Civil Servants' Senior Corps of State Economists and Trade Specialists. She holds an MBA from IE Business School and also an MSc and a PhD in Pharmacy.
